## LOCAL RULES

### OUT OF BOUNDS

Beyond all course boundaries, within the area of the greenkeeper's buildings, the car parks, clubhouse and hotel and surrounding paved areas and flower beds, the putting greens, the fence on LHS of the 1st and beyond the bank behind the 18th green. Proceed under Rule 18.2

### POWER LINES

If a player's ball hit a power line or pole supporting a power line, the stroke does not count. The player **must** play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made (see Rule 14.6 for what to do).

### YOUNG TREES THAT ARE STAKED OR NETTED

If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a penalty area and it lies on or touches such a tree or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player **must** take relief under Rule 16.1f.

### NO PLAY ZONES

Additional areas where free relief must be taken are defined on the Notice Boards in the locker rooms and pro-shop.

### ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS

Additional areas where free relief may be taken are defined on the same Notice Boards.

### DRY STONE WALLS

are an integral part of the course and **NO** relief may be taken.

### PACE OF PLAY

Expected times for a 4 ball to play:

Front 9: **2hrs 5mins**

Back 9: **1hr 55mins**

18 holes: **4 hrs**

2 or 3 ball formats are expected to be quicker.

For all forms of strokeplay, "Ready Golf" is recommended, i.e. play when in position and safe to do so.

Once in position and your turn, you have 40 seconds to prepare for and play your shot.

You have a maximum of 3 minutes to find your ball.

**Players are encouraged to allow faster groups to play through.**
